

UNITED STATES REGIONAL PRIVACY NOTICE

Last updated and effective date: December 1, 2023

This United States Regional Privacy Notice ("Privacy Notice") is for people living in the United States and supplements the information contained in the <u>Aras Privacy Policy</u>. This Privacy Notice explains how Aras Corporation and its subsidiaries and affiliated companies ("Aras," "we," or "us") collect, use and disclose your Personal Data. It also describes how to exercise your rights under the California Consumer Privacy Act ("CCPA"), and other U.S. state laws applicable to consumers in their jurisdiction (collectively, the "U.S. Privacy Laws").

For purposes of this Privacy Notice, "Personal Data" or "personal information" means information that identifies, relates to, describes, is reasonably capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a particular consumer or household in the states subject to the U.S. Privacy Laws. This Privacy Policy does not apply to publicly available information lawfully made available by state or federal government records, deidentified information, aggregate consumer information, or other personal information that is exempt under applicable U.S. Privacy Laws. U.S. Privacy Laws may not apply in some jurisdictions to Personal Data of individuals acting in a commercial or employment context, such as a job applicant. We strongly encourage you to read this Privacy Notice in its entirety.

While our collection, use and disclosure of personal information varies based upon our relationship and interactions with you, in this Privacy Notice we describe, generally, how we have collected and disclosed personal information about California residents in the prior 12 months (from the Last Updated date above), and the rights California residents have under the CCPA regarding this personal information.

Rights Concerning Personal Data

Depending on where you live and subject to certain exceptions, you may have the following rights concerning collection, use, sharing and deletion of Personal Data:

- **Right to Know**. You have the right to request information about the categories of Personal Data we have collected about you, the categories of sources from which we collected the Personal Data, the purposes for collecting, selling, or sharing the Personal Data, and the categories of third parties with whom we have shared, sold, or disclosed your Personal Data, as well as the specific pieces of Personal Data we have collected about you.
- **Right to Delete**. You have the right to request that we delete Personal Data that we have collected from you.
- **Right to Opt-Out of Sale or Sharing**. You may request that businesses stop selling or sharing your personal information ("opt-out"). We do not sell or share your Personal Data.
- **Right to Non-Discrimination**. We will not discriminate against those California residents who choose to exercise their CCPA rights.
- **Right to Correct**. You have the right to request that we correct inaccurate Personal Data that we have about you.
- Right to Limit. You have the right to limit the use and disclosure of sensitive personal information (e.g., your social security number, financial account information, your precise geolocation data, or your genetic data) collected about you. We do not request or maintain sensitive personal information.

Verification: In order to process rights requests, we may need to obtain information to locate you in our records or verify your identity depending on the nature of the request. In most cases, we will collect some or all of the following data elements: first and last name, email address, and telephone number. In some cases, we may request different or additional information, including a signed declaration that you are who you say you are. We will inform you if we need such information.

Authorized Agents: Authorized agents may exercise rights on behalf of you by submitting a request by contacting us at privacy@aras.com. Any person acting as an authorized agent on behalf of another person must indicate so when submitting a request. We may require the authorized agent to demonstrate authority to act on your behalf by providing signed permission from you. We may also require you to verify your own identity directly with us or to directly confirm with us that you provided the authorized agent permission to submit the request.

Timing: We will respond to requests within 45 days unless we need more time, in which case we will notify you and may take up to 90 days total to respond to your request.
